At Churchill Academy & Sixth Form we believe that we should support our students' personal development by providing opportunities that they may not otherwise experience. A key element of this is our programme of residential trips in the UK and abroad. These trips offer an unrivalled opportunity for the students to learn, develop and build their skills, knowledge, character and confidence beyond the classroom. They help forge new friendships and enhance their social skills through interactions with new cultures and beliefs as well as interacting with their peers in a new, unfamiliar and sometime challenging environment.

Included in this brochure are the residential trips that we are offering to our students for 2024-2025. It also includes information on residential trips that we operate on a rotation and should be departing in 2026/27 but will be launched in 2024/2025.

Payment for trips is through ParentPay. A non-returnable deposit of £100 will be needed and places are reserved on a first come basis following receipt of the payment. Payment schedules are always available should you wish to spread the cost. These schedules are often set by the tour companies. Please note that there is always a minimum number of students to make the trip viable.



Springhead lies at the foot of north Dorset's most spectacular downland. The downs, on the western edge of an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, command stunning views over the Blackmore Vale and Hardy's Wessex. At the entrance, a range of thatched cottages and an 18th century mill house form a courtyard. A small pool at its centre is fed by running water that cascades beneath the mill house to become a gentle stream, flowing into the River Stour.

At the head of the lake, where the chalk of the downs meets the greensand of the vale, icy, clear water bubbles up from seven mysterious springs that are crossed by a wooden bridge and overshadowed by huge and veteran trees.


